- **D 1**. Review Monthly Financials and Unaudited Actuals (Absolute Charter Group; Christopher Williams)
- **D 2.** Executive Director Monthly Report (Oral Report) Welcome back Board Chair Davis, Secretary Dolores-Gonzales and Board Members. Thank you to the Board Members who attended the Brown Act training with Young Minney and Corr, Legal. For those that did not attend, I will ensure that you have the annual Brown Act training. AB 2449 will go into effect on January 1, 2023. Our team is excited about the expanded classrooms. JLPAA is working on obtaining land for continued growth. The Universal Kinder reporting is due by September 30, 2022. The principal and ED will be attending a conference hosted by CAAASA (Equity in Action on research, policies, and practices. The ED will be on vacation starting October 17<sup>th</sup> and back on October 27<sup>th</sup>. Current enrollment is 433, with an original forecast of 438. JLPAA is utilizing ELOP funding for the afterschool program. JLPAA will present data to RCBE on November 2, 2022 at 5pm, I would love for all members to attend if you can.
- **D** 3. Principal Monthly Report (Oral Report) JLPAA started the 2022-2023 school year with
  - 26 teachers (includes 4 SPED teachers), 24 paraeducators, 1 physical education part-time coach, 1 full time counselor), 1 EL full-time teacher
  - 434 students in grades TK-8<sup>th</sup> grade

Newly added for 2022-2023 school year:

- Visual & Performing Arts (VAPA) every class receives 45 minutes per day
- Middle school (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>) receives 45 minutes daily of PE
- The 1<sup>st</sup>- 5<sup>th</sup> receive PE every Friday for 30 minutes

- TK & Kindergarten will be visited by the library van every Friday for literacy development (read aloud)
- Completed the NWEA testing for K-8 students August 30-Spetember 9, 2022
- Completed the Williams visits for the **Textbook Sufficiency Report** on August 23<sup>rd</sup>. All textbooks and instructional materials were accounted for. The 7<sup>th</sup> grade math books arrived a day after the visit, but a picture was sent to the reviewer. She expected it as the PO and invoice was given to her during the visit.
- The new Ks and TKs students were administered the Initial ELPAC assessment. All students have been accounted for. JLPAA has 47 ELD students/11%.
- IEP meetings are being scheduled, JLPAA has 70 SPED students/16%.
- California Healthy Youth Act information was uploaded to the JLPAA website. Two parent
  meetings were schedule for September 20<sup>th</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> from 5:30-7:00pm to explain and distribute

- JLPAA has purchased new curriculum for the following: Math grades: 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>; Social Studies grades: TK-5<sup>th</sup>; ELA: Middle school novel studies; Science grades: 6<sup>th</sup>-8th

**D 4.** IT Manager and Facilities Manager Monthly Report (Oral Report) The facilities team did a great job conducting an inventory for books, desk, chrome books, prior to the start of the new year. The IT and facilities team is in the process of preparing for the first scheduled assessment, utilizing NWEA. Lunch applications have gone out to all students. The team is also working on CalPads and errors that occurred during an upgrade. This year we serve lunch four different times due to the schools growth. The team is also working on facility improvements utilizing the kitchen grant. We will keep the Board informed on the kitchen expansion.
